 Emergency Medical Services
 Program began in 1991. It is
 approved by the Oklahoma State
 Department of Health-Emergency
 Medical Services Division.

The Program provides selected
 students with educational
 opportunities in classroom and
 clinical settings, and to prepare
 them for paramedic licensure.

Upon successful course
 completion, graduates of AAS
 degree in Emergency Medical
 Services are eligible to take the
 National Registry Examination to
 become licensed as a Paramedic.
 Pre-Hospital Trauma Life Support
 (PHTLS), Advanced Cardiac Life
 Support(ACLS), and Pediatric
 Advanced Life Support(PALS)
 courses are included in the
 curriculum. The graduate is
 prepared at an entry level of
 practice and will require
 continuing education, both formal
 and informal, to advance in
 clinical expertise.

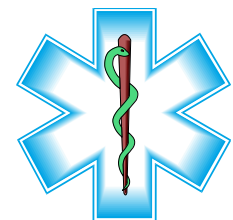
