



Dear Prospective Student:

Thank you for inquiring about the Emergency Medical Services Program at Rogers State University. Upon successful course completion, graduates of RSU EMS courses are eligible to take the National Registry Exam and be a licensed at one of two levels, Basic EMT or Paramedic.

In order to enroll into any EMS course, you must first be admitted to the University. If you are a first time entering college student, a transfer student, or re-entering Rogers State University student, contact the office of Enrollment Management to apply for admission or re-admission. You can apply for admission at any of our three campuses, Markham Hall on the Claremore Campus, Pryor, or Bartlesville. It is important that you bring your scholastic records with you. Important records include:

- ◆ High school transcript with graduation date or GED.
- ◆ ACT or SAT scores
- ◆ Other college or university transcripts

If you need additional information on the application process, the Office of Enrollment Management can be reached 918-343-7546. Instructions and an application form are included in this packet.

You will then need to schedule into an enrollment session. These sessions are designed for the Basic. In order to guarantee a seat in the class, students are encouraged to apply for admission into the University and enroll into an enrollment session at the earliest opportunity. For dates and to register, contact our office at 918-343-7635. Please bring the following items with you to the enrollment session:

- ✓ Permit to enroll
- ✓ Photocopies of transcripts from all previous high school or a copy of your GED and college work
- ✓ ACT or other placement scores
- ✓ Copy of schedule if you are currently enrolled at another institution.
