PARTICIPANT RULES

1. CANDY OR OTHER ITEMS CAN **NOT** BE THROWN FROM A MOVING VEHICLE. (EVEN IF THE VEHICLE IS STOPPED). CANDY MAY BE THROWN BY PARTICIPANTS WALKING ALONGSIDE THE ENTRY. THIS IS NOW A CITY ORDINANCE AND IF BROKEN, THEY HAVE THE RIGHT TO REMOVE THE ENTRY FROM THE REMAINDER OF THE PARADE.
2. ALL FLOATS MUST HAVE FIRE EXTINGUISHERS. (THE FIRE MARSHALL WILL CHECK EACH FLOAT PRIOR TO THE START OF THE PARADE.)
3. IF RIDING A MOTORSCOOTER, MINI BIKE, GO-CART, ETC. THE DRIVER MUST WEAR A HELMET IF UNDER THE AGE OF 18.
4. LINE UP WILL BEGIN AT 1:15 PM AT THE EXPO CENTER (VETERANS PARKWAY ROAD). THE PARADE WILL BEGIN PROMPTLY AT 2:00 PM AND FINISH AT THE GAZEBO/FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH PARKING AREA.
5. EACH ENTRY WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR TEARING DOWN AND CLEANING UP THE AREAS AROUND THEIR FLOAT.
