Students who are legal residents of Oklahoma and have **financial need** and/or exhibit **scholastic achievement** are eligible to apply for a waiver of tuition. Scholarships are awarded for one year.

Application for a scholarship is made by submitting a Scholarship Application, along with other required documents, as requested below, to the Office of Financial Aid. **The deadline for Scholarship Applications is March 1. Applications received after this date may not be considered for awarding purposes.**

Scholarships for scholastic achievement are based on ACT scores, G.P.A., or other criteria. They are awarded for the following amounts based on the stated scholastic achievement:

- ACT scores (Unless transfer with 24 college credit hours earned)
- High school transcript or G.E.D. scores
- College transcripts from previous institutions

Recipients will receive an award letter with an agreement that must be signed and returned to the Office of Financial Aid verifying acceptance of the scholarship. Scholarships will not be awarded until the signed agreement is returned. **Agreements received after the deadline date may not be awarded.**

A completed FAFSA must be on file with the Department of Education and RSU must be listed as a university you are considering on your FAFSA. Each student may receive only one RSU tuition waiver, although the student may qualify for more than one tuition waiver.

Students must complete this application in full. Incomplete or illegible applications will not be considered.
