Guidelines & Procedures

What's Expected From PLC Members

- The President's Leadership Class (PLC) awards full tuition and fees (minus any other federal, state, and/or private grants and scholarships) free on-campus housing and \$500 per semester Scholar Dollars for each class member.
- PLC members are expected to attend all regular meetings, special projects, and official gatherings of the class.
- PLC members are expected to volunteer for campus service projects, be active members of student organizations, and be on-call for campus events.
- Each PLC member is expected to attend selected RSU Alumni programs and Foundation events.
- Each PLC member is expected to visit selected high schools with RSU recruiters.
- Each PLC member is expected to live in on-campus student housing during his/her freshman and sophomore years.
- Each PLC member is expected to complete a minimum of 30 semester credits per academic year.
- Each PLC member is expected to maintain a GPA of 3.00.

Application Procedure

To be considered for the President's Leadership Class (PLC) at RSU, students must have a minimum ACT composite score of 21 and be admitted into a baccalaureate program. Students who are pursuing an RSU associate degree in nursing and who intend to pursue an RSU bachelor degree in nursing, and students who are pursuing an RSU associate degree in elementary education and intend to enter the RSU/Cameron University elementary education program, will be considered for membership in the PLC. The PLC awards will only cover tuition and fees at RSU, not Cameron University courses taught on the RSU campus.

A completed application packet must be delivered to the address listed above by February 1, 2012. The completed packet will include:

- Completed PLC application and activity form
- Your current high school and/or college transcript
- A copy of your ACT scores
- Three (3) recommendation forms** to be completed by references who are familiar with your leadership accomplishments. At least two must be academic references – teachers from high school or college. Your references should complete the recommendations privately, seal their recommendation form in an envelope, and place their signature across the envelope seal.
