

Program Description

The Bachelor of Science in Nursing is designed to prepare an entry-level practitioner. The program was approved by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education in 2016 and the first class of nursing students is scheduled to graduate in May of 2021. The Oklahoma Board of Nursing has granted provisional approval to start a 4-year bachelor's degree in nursing and the program will seek national accreditation. Admission is competitive.

Notice

The Rogers State BSN program is provisionally approved by the Oklahoma Board of Nursing. Applicants for Oklahoma licensure must meet all state and federal requirements to hold an Oklahoma license to practice nursing. In addition to completing a state-approved nursing education program, requirements include submission of an application for licensure, which includes submitting a fingerprint criminal history records search conducted by the FBI and the OSBI not more than 3 months prior to submission of the application [59 O.S. §567.5] and successfully passing the licensure examination. To be granted a license, an applicant must have the legal right to reside in the United States (United States Code Chapter 8, Section 1621). The board has the right to deny a license to an individual with a history of a criminal background, disciplinary action on another health-related license or certification, or judicial declaration of mental incompetence [59 O.S. §567.8]. These cases are considered on an individual basis at the time application for licensure is made, with the exception of felony charges. An individual with a felony conviction or who had a sentencing imposed by the court related to a deferred sentence for a felony offence cannot apply for a license for at least five years after the completion of all sentencing terms, including probation and suspended sentences, unless a presidential or gubernatorial pardon is received [59 O.S. §567.5, 567.6, & 567.6a].

The Board of Nursing, by law, has the authority and legal jurisdiction over basic educational programs, nursing practice, and nursing licensure in Oklahoma. The Oklahoma Nurse Practice Act and Rules are available on the Oklahoma Board of Nursing website.

Applications for admission into the BSN program will be available beginning **November 1**, **2018 thru February 1**, **2019**.

- Accepted to Rogers State University
- 2. Reading Score of: ACT Reading 19 or Nelson Deny 13.
- All academic deficiencies cleared, including Computer Science. Computer Science
 may be achieved through Advanced Standing or successfully passing CS 1113
 Microcomputer Applications with a grade of "C" or better.
- 4. Required GPA of a 2.5 in all required prerequisite coursework, and no less than a grade of "C" in any prerequisite nursing course. All prerequisite courses must be completed by the end of the spring semester in which application is submitted.
