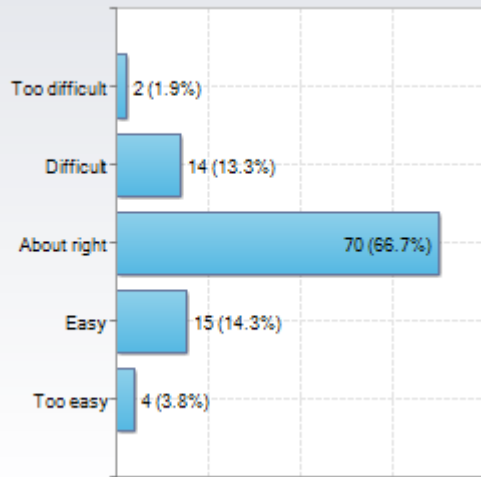

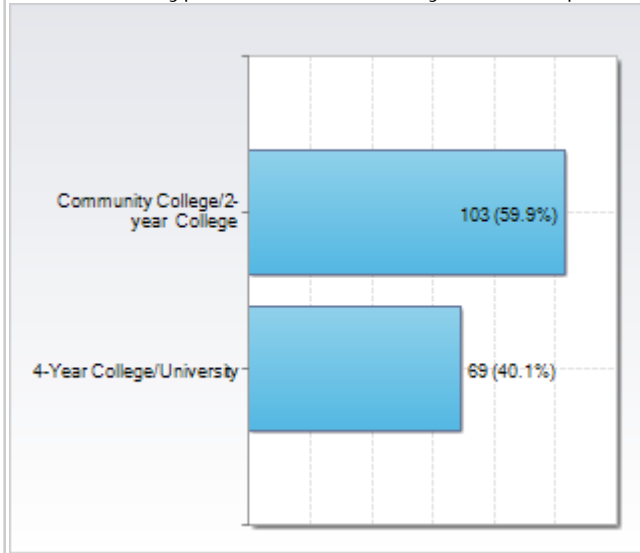

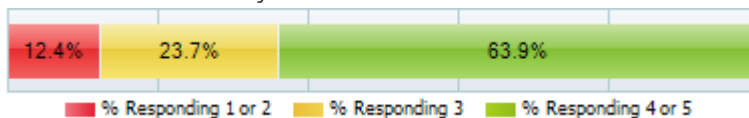

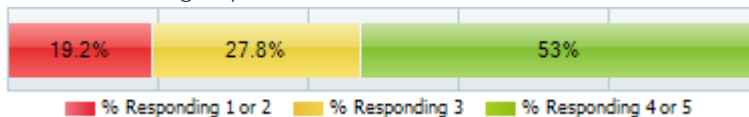

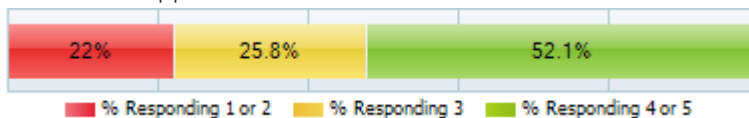

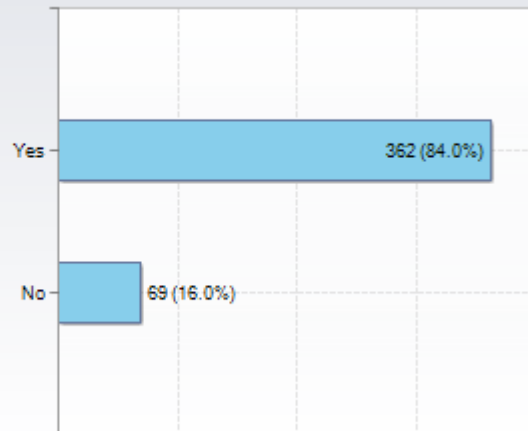

Q002. Reasons for Enrollment - To what degree: Do you understand this institution's intended learning goals for the first year of college?

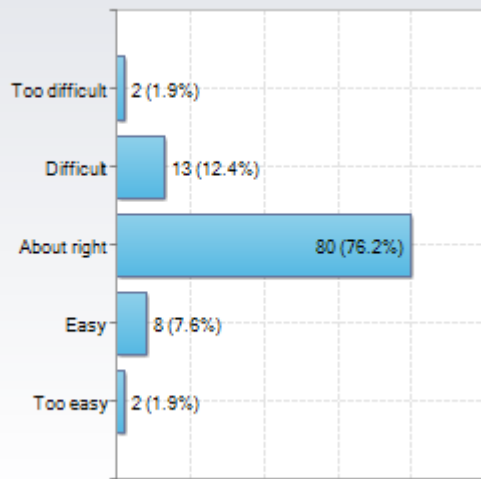

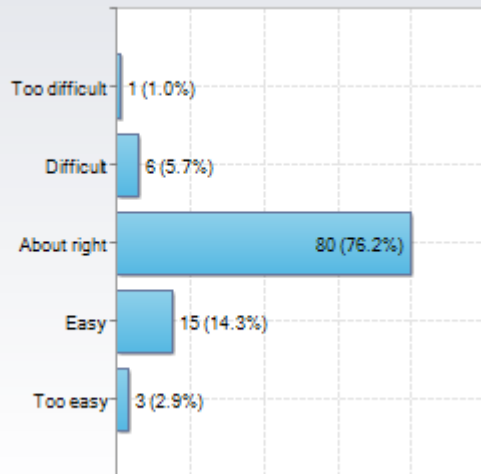

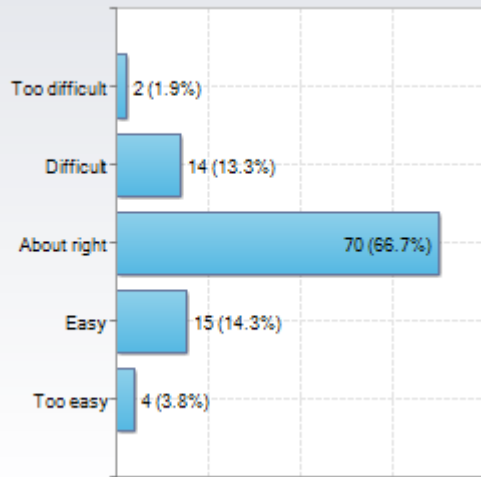

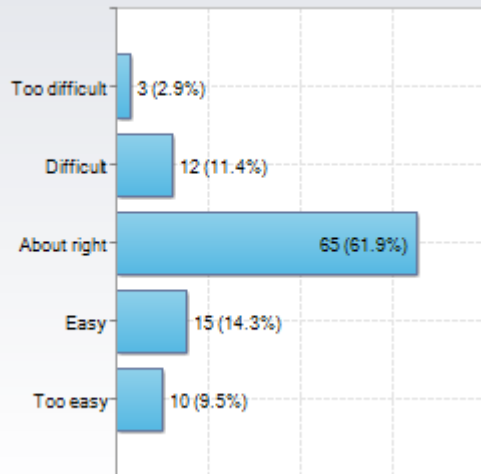

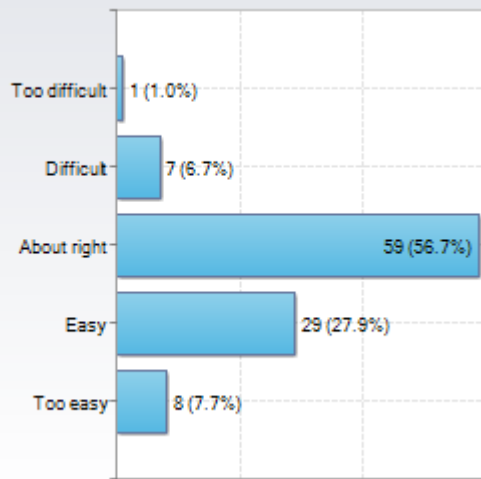

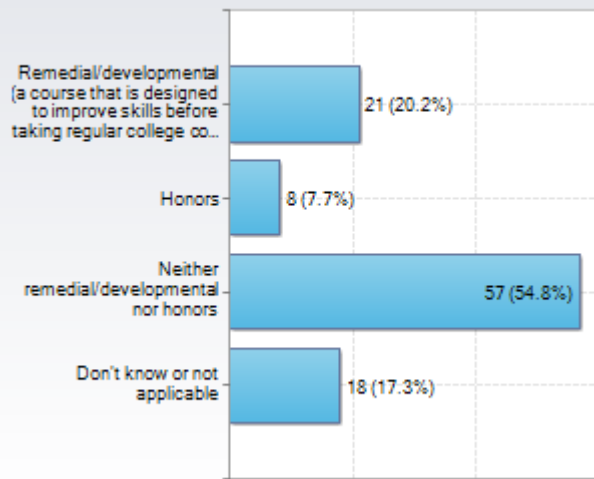

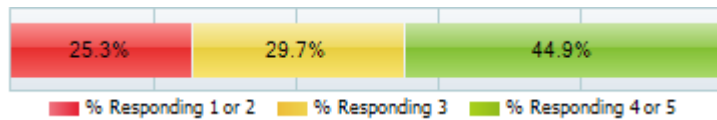

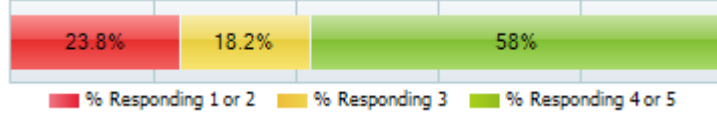

Q012. Transfer Process - In transferring to this institution, to what degree: Was it easy for you to find information related to transfer on this institution's website?

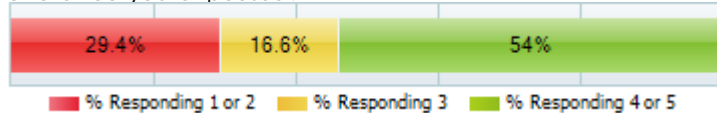

Q013. Transfer Process - In transferring to this institution, to what degree: Did your courses from previous institutions transfer as you expected?

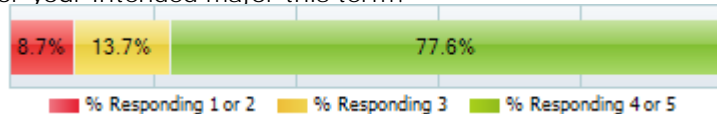

Q014. Transfer Process - In transferring to this institution, to what degree: Were you able to enroll in the courses you need for your intended major this term?

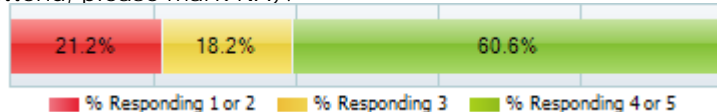

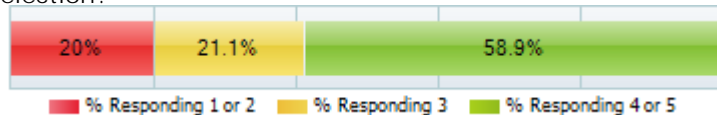

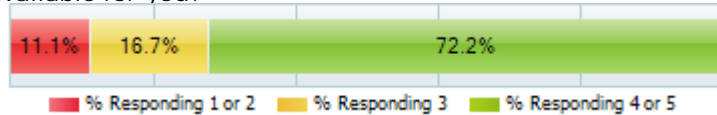

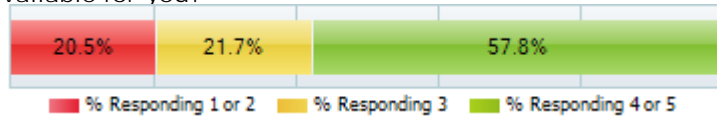

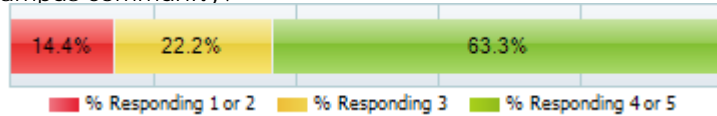
