## 10. Comments:

Campus policies are not enforced and students are not held accountable. Why should I follow the rules when nobody gets in trouble for breaking them? Residential Life never listened to any complaints and was slow to take action, I.E. the terrible WiFi connection in UVC throughout the whole year. The quality of sodexo food has seriously declined. During the first weeks of classes, or when large events are going on, the food is great. They put effort into the food because they want to impress people. As soon

- as those events are going on, the food quality is terrible again. I kept finding hairs in my food, and many students felt sick after eating there. Having the dining hall open during breaks would also be nice for students that have to stay on campus. The UVC dorms were really nice and had a great community feel to them. Great idea, it really helped the freshman bond and get to know each other. I enjoyed all my professors and found they were all willing to help me understand concepts if I had questions. Overall, I did enjoy my year at RSU but there are some areas that could be improved. Thanks.

The professors I work with are amazing but it is becoming very apparent that they are over loaded and the work load expected of each is stretching them thin an making them less available to the students.
- I do not like the 4 day schedule that RSU tried this year. It is hard on the biology students when we have such hard and compact classes. Also, the science labs need updated desperately. The pathways on the nature trail are a danger. RSU holds many 5k races on campus and I have known non-students to attend these races and get seriously injured due to the paths. This could eventually cause a lawsuit for RSU if not attended to.
- RSU needs to work on the advisors and their role of advising. If that is their job...they need to do it. The History department advisors (some of them) are not good at all and no one knows how to communicate.

Faculty accessibility and accountability for some online courses could be reviewed. Some classes have not had but one

- or two grades recorded nearing the end of the semester. This does not allow a student to adjust their performance to optimum levels. How can a student know where they stand in a class if very few grades are recorded? Other than that, the RSU experience has been stellar.
- The head of the science department needs to be evaluated. Professor Graham isn't involved with her students, she is rude 13. and doesn't seem to care about her students. It took multiple people weeks to do homework online because she ignored our emails and wouldn't help fix the issue. I hope this isn't behavior RSU allows, and hope that it is corrected.
