- Reading Score of: ACT Reading 19, RSU Reading Accuplacer 75, RSU Next-Gen 250, or Nelson-Denny 13
- Required prerequisite GPA of 2.5 or higher. Ranking will use the most recent grades.
- A minimum grade of 'C' is required in all nursing and prerequisite courses to meet the requirements for admission/graduation.

## Ranking Criteria

- 1) 6 pre-requisite courses—individual grade and completion points will be awarded. Must be complete by the end of the fall semester before your program year in order to receive grade and completion points.
  - General Cellular Biology
  - Anatomy
  - Chemistry
  - College Algebra
  - Development Psychology
  - Nutrition
  
- 2) Pre-requisite GPA of the applicant broken down in the following chart with points declining each section.
  - 4.0
  - 3.99-3.8
  - 3.79-3.6
  - 3.59-3.4
  - 3.39-3.2
  - 3.19-3.0
  
- 3) There will be bonus points awarded for 5 pre-requisite courses if taken at RSU.
  - General Cellular Biology
  - Eng. Composition I
  - Anatomy
  - Physiology
  - Statistics
  
- 4) There will be points awarded for the completion of a previous degree
  
- 5) There will be additional (tie-breaker) points awarded for the following courses:
  - Psychology
  - Composition I
  - Microbiology
  - Statistics
  
- 6) There will be a deduction for not having all materials turned in by the deadline.
