### Practice your English

The Duolingo English Test measures reading, writing, speaking, and listening. Any way that you learn and practice English helps you prepare for the test. There are a lot of great free resources online!



### Take a sample test

Familiarize yourself with the types of questions that are on the Duolingo English Test! The sample test is free and you can take it as many times as you want.

### Prepare your test environment

You must have:

- A government-issued photo [ID](#)
- A quiet, well-lit room
- 45 minutes of your time
- A computer with a webcam
- An internet connection and compatible [browser](#)

### Follow the rules

After you complete your test, a proctor will review your test video to ensure you followed the rules. Please pay attention to these rules during the test so your test can be certified, or you will need to take the test again. The test rules include not wearing earphones, not interacting with anyone else, not using your phone or other devices, and not looking off-screen.
