Fall 2023 Enrollment

- 3,219 students
- 451 first-time freshmen
- 36,190 semester credit hours
- 2,413 FTE (Full-time Equivalent)
- 526 concurrently enrolled high school students

Student Characteristics

- 48% first-generation college students
- 75% employed while attending full-time
- 75% receive financial aid
 - \$4,245 average semester financial aid package for those receiving
 - \$2,837 average total Pell for those receiving
- 18:1 student-to-faculty ratio
- > 30 student organizations and clubs
- 12 athletic teams plus eSports video gaming
 - Two national championships in 2021-2022
- 38 degrees and certificates with 76 options and foci
 - 12 associates degrees (19 options)
 - 22 bachelor's degrees (44 options + 8 foci)
 - 37 minors
 - 2 graduate degrees (5 options)
 - 2 certificates

Student Success

- 63% retention rate for first-time freshman baccalaureate cohort (fall 2021 to fall 2022)
- 55% retention rate for first-time freshman baccalaureate cohort (fall 2020 to fall 2021)
 - 65% regional peer average for comparison (fall 2020 to fall 2021)
- 31% six-year graduation rate for first-time freshman baccalaureate cohort (fall 2016 cohort)
- 34% six-year graduation rate for first-time freshman baccalaureate cohort (fall 2015 cohort)
 - 32% regional peer average for comparison (fall 2013 cohort)
- 57% six-year success rate (graduation rate + transfer rate)
